

INSTRUCTIONS AND CARE FOR MARCHING BAND UNIFORMS

- Student is responsible for all parts of their uniform and replacement if damaged or lost.
 - You may have the jacket sleeves or jumpsuits hemmed but do not cut material off. Modern Dry Cleaners does repairs for a small fee. Marching on the hem of the jumpsuit will ruin the bottom. You will be charged to replace the entire jumpsuit if this happens.
 - You may wear dark shorts or sweatpants under jumpsuit. **No zippers.** Wear t-shirts not Sleeveless shirts under your jacket.
 - Check for any loose buttons or snaps on the jacket and stitch as needed.
 - **Dry clean only** the jacket and jumpsuit. (You may hand wash the collar protector). Remove baldric(front sash) and cape(back sash) before dry-cleaning. If the baldric is soiled you may clean it with a small amount of water and Ivory soap with a toothbrush.
 - Do not wash or hand clean any part of the uniform. Take to dry-cleaner ASAP for stains. (Be careful at football games with ketchup or mustard.)
 - We will offer four “bulk” cleanings through season at the cost of \$8.00 for the jacket and jumpsuit. You may prepay for the cleanings but make 4 individual checks to “Modern Cleaners” not EBPA.
 - Do not store uniform wet. Hang up to dry after games or competitions outside of garment bag. Do not use hair dryer or clothes dryer!
 - We purchased 80 new raincoats this season. Raincoats may be washed as needed. Instructions given by company:
Wash cold water, gentle cycle. Mild detergent air dry completely to prevent mildew.
Do not dry clean. Do not store damp.
